Salida Aspen Concerts 35th season begins July 9

The 35th Anniversary season of the annual Salida Aspen concert series, featuring internationally recognized artists and exciting new talent from the Aspen Music Festival, and School, gets underway with four events in July and two more in August.

Earle Kittleman, president of Salida Aspen Concerts, promises the series "will present some of the best talent we have ever had" performing classical and contemporary music.

Sat. July 9, pianist Wu Han will be joined by **Rita Sloan**, with **Brian Ghee and Lily Finckel**. They will play selected music for piano, four hands; and one piece for piano, eight hands.





Sat. July 16 will feature pianist **Simone Dinnerstein**, whose “Bach, A Strange Beauty” was #1 on the Billboard Classical Chart. Among her selections will be Bach’s Goldberg Variations—the work that propelled her into the international spotlight.



Sat. July 23, the **American Brass Quintet**, now in its 51st year, will return to Salida to perform music from the Renaissance to the present.



Sat. July 30, Greek pianist **Dimitri Papadimitriou** will perform “A Musical Triptych” with violinist **Robyn Bollinger** and cellist **Meta Weiss**. Papadimitriou will solo on the piano, and the three will perform Rachmaninoff’s Piano Trio in G Minor.



Sat. Aug. 6, **the Jupiter Quartet**—which last performed in Salida two years ago—will return to play one of the Beethoven Quartets. This summer they are playing all 16 of the Quartets at the Aspen Music Festival.

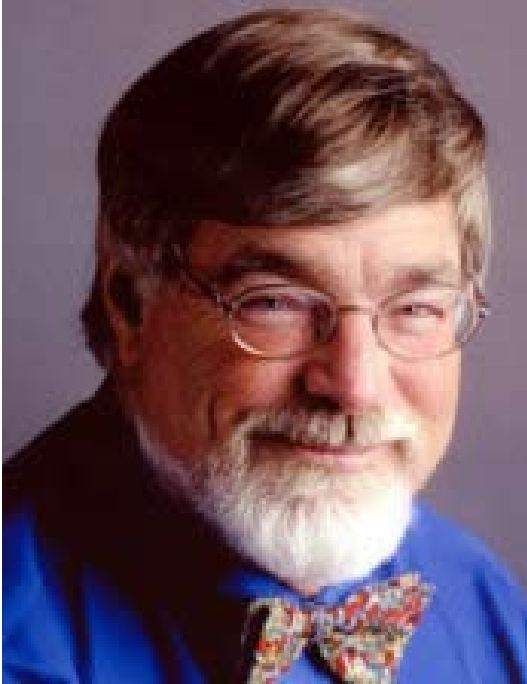


Fri. Aug. 12, pianist **Inon Barnatan** returns to Salida for his third consecutive year. A recognized Schubert expert, he will play one of Franz Schubert’s works with an Aspen string ensemble.

Artists have found studio tours a profitable way to boost sales, connect with clients on a personal

level, and acquaint potential collectors with their work. The first Salida studio tour in 2009 was such a success that in 2010 Buena Vista launched their own tour. It now will be an annual event, alternating between the two towns each year.

As if he weren't busy enough painting, showing and conducting workshops...turns out Josh Been has been inventing too! The noted Salida landscape artist just unveiled his "Prolific Easel" (patent pending), a savvy innovation specifically designed for plein air painters.

Been's new easel is lightweight for high-adventure hike-ins; efficient for pulling off the side of the road, setting up and painting; and super-stable in wind. "All you need is a heavy duty tripod", claims Been, "attach this thing to it and you are set."

Able to hold any size panel from 1"x1" to up to 4 feet vertical, the easel has a detachable slot box which can carry six 1/8", 12x16" panels or twelve 8x12" panels--or multiple sizes in its patented double-slotted system. The glass mixing-palette area is a spacious 11.5x15.5" in size, with double fold out side arms that offer an additional 8x12" area each for brushes, turpentine jar, etc.
