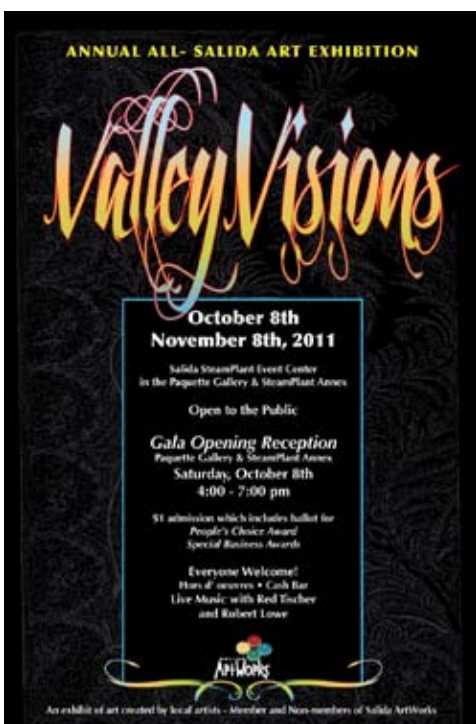

Salida Studio Tour lauded by artists

Twenty-two of the area's most prominent artists welcomed visitors to their studios on Sept. 9-10 for ArtWorks' 2011 Salida Studio Tour...and virtually all pronounced it a rewarding success.

In a post-tour survey, participating artists reported an amazing average of more than 70 visitors per studio; and organizers estimate a total 400 tour-goers from throughout Salida and Colorado attended. The artists' ratings for overall satisfaction were "good" to "excellent"; and 85% said they would do the Tour again. Immediate sales varied from great to ho-hum depending on the artist; but all made valuable connections with collectors, fans, and potential new customers.

Sherrie York linocut Ripples is making big waves



Salida artist Sherrie York recently enjoyed a double whammy of good news over her juicy new linocut, *Ripples*. First, it was juried into the internationally acclaimed *Birds In Art* exhibition at Wisconsin's Leigh Yawkey Woodson Art Museum. And then, upon her return to Salida after the show, Sherrie was notified that the museum is adding her piece to their permanent collection.

Sherrie York poses with "*Ripples*" at the Sept. 9 preview reception of *Birds In Art*, attended by shoulder-to-shoulder crowds celebrating the Wisconsin exhibit's 36th anniversary.

"It feels good to get a major 'atta girl' from the Woodson," says Sherrie. "They actually own three other of my pieces, too--two much older watercolors (twenty years ago!) and one drawing." She adds, "The opening weekend is really a sort of 'artist-as-rockstar' experience--which is half the motivation for trying to get into the show at all."

Every year the annual *Birds In Art* exhibition attracts over a thousand entries from artists throughout the world. This year, following the preview opening, Sherrie and seven other exhibition artists also demonstrated their work techniques for enthusiastic audiences. Her reduction-printing demo also was a news feature on Wausau's WAOW television.

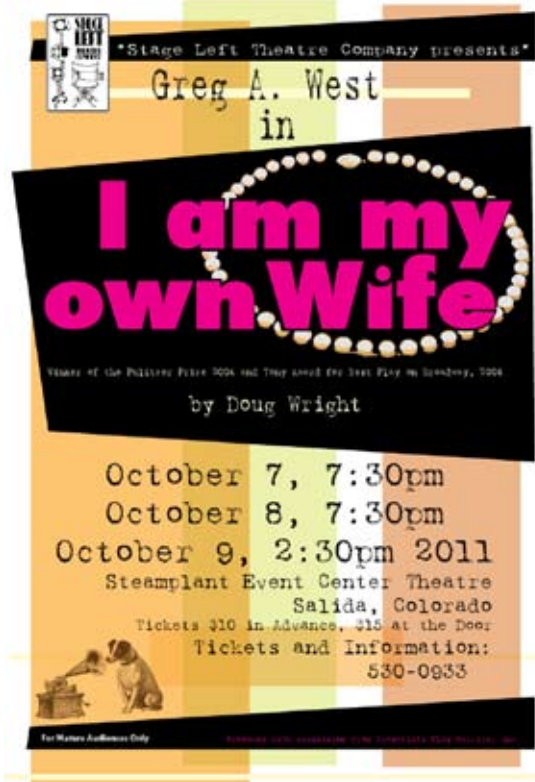
Salida Circus schedules new Oct. & Nov. performances

by Salida's PJ Bergin.

"When I am working on the layout for a new Glow Box", says PJ, "I blend colors as an artist covers a traditional canvas with paint. My design is an abstract 'painting' but the medium here is wool fiber. The 'canvas' I use is created with silk chiffon and wool. Then I use the LED lights to illuminate the piece from within its frame."
