Colorado Art Ranch is moving its HQ to Salida!

Colorado Art Ranch, the visionary arts organization that sponsors artist Residencies and "Artposiums" throughout the State, is moving its headquarters to Salida from the Front Range.

The group's Director, Grant Pound, will continue to reside in Denver but will spend much of his time here at the new home base.

According to local author Susan Tweit, Art Ranch will office in the studio of her late husband, sculptor Richard Cabe. Before Richard's passing last November, the couple decided to dedicate his studio and their guest cottage in central Salida to Art Ranch, creating the "Richard Cabe Terraphilia Artist/Writer Residency". Contributions made to Art Ranch in his memory will go toward funding this Residency program.

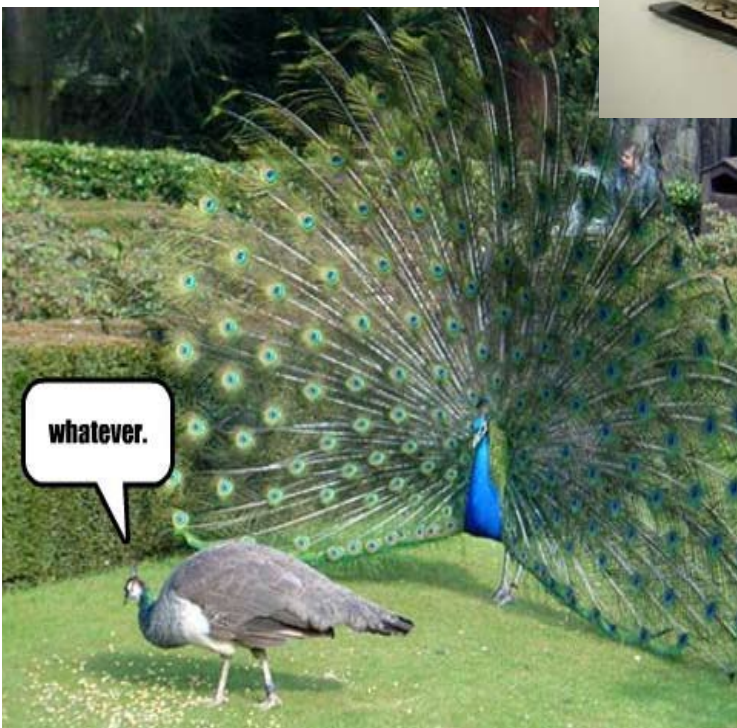
