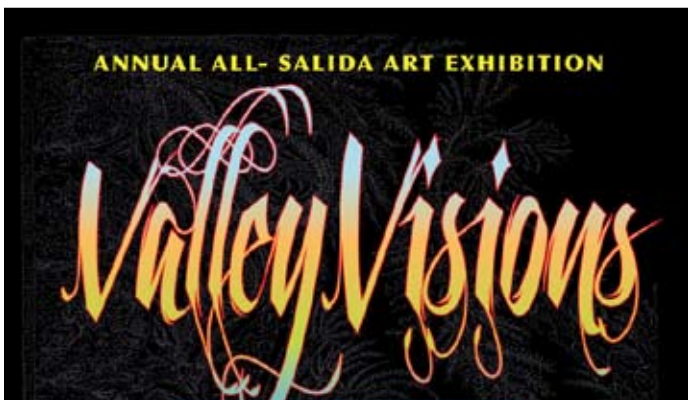

## 6 artists share top honors at Valley Visions show



More 100 locals and out-of-towners flocked to the SteamPlant on Oct. 8 for the grand opening of Salida ArtWorks' big annual "Valley Visions" art exhibition. Billed as a tour-de-force of creative talent in Salida and surrounding areas, the show attracted

an impressive collection of new works by nearly fifty of the region's most accomplished artists.



Voting for the People's Choice Awards resulted in a surprising 3-way tie for first place. Winners were:

**Joanie Barbier** -- for her gouache gicleé "Snowy Bike"

**Jim Dickson** -- for his pen/ink/colored pencil work "Abandoned"

**Padgett McFeely** -- for her mixed media/oil painting "Being in a State of Fusion"

Business Awards--sponsored and chosen by local firms--went to:

**Shara Briggs** -- Art Matters Gallery Award for her pastel "Untitled"

**Janine Frazee** -- Bank of the West Award for her ceramic/mixed media "Memories of Childhood"

**Ralph Parker** -- The Book Haven Award for his glass sculpture "Oriental Dream"

The packed grand-opening party was highlighted by a smorgasbord of gourmet treats catered by Artworks, and live music by guitarist **Red Tischer** and pianist **Robert Loewe**. Housed throughout both the Paquette Gallery and Annex, the show remains on display through Nov. 8. All art is for sale, with 70% going to the artist, 20% to the SteamPlant, and 10% to ArtWorks.

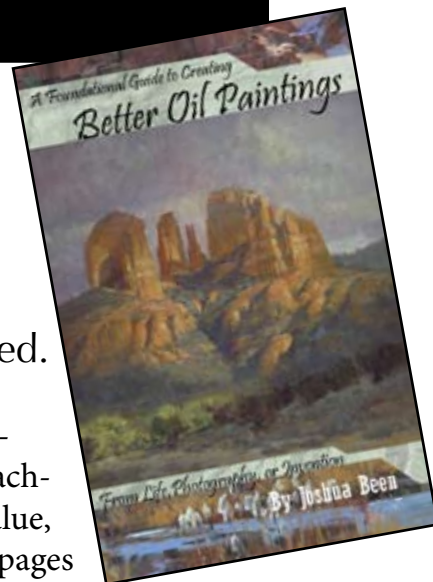

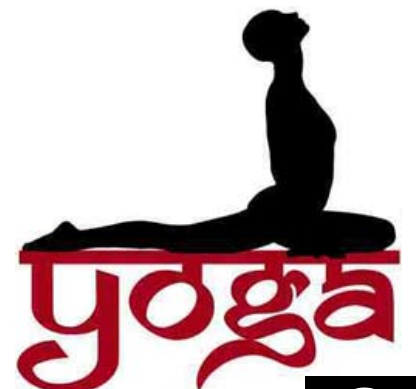
## Writers Exchange "Word Yoga" workshop is Nov. 19

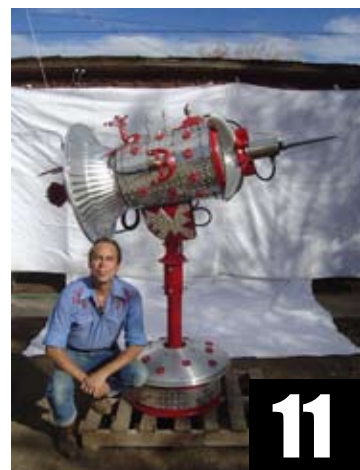
